- ☐ The police come to arrest Fagin.

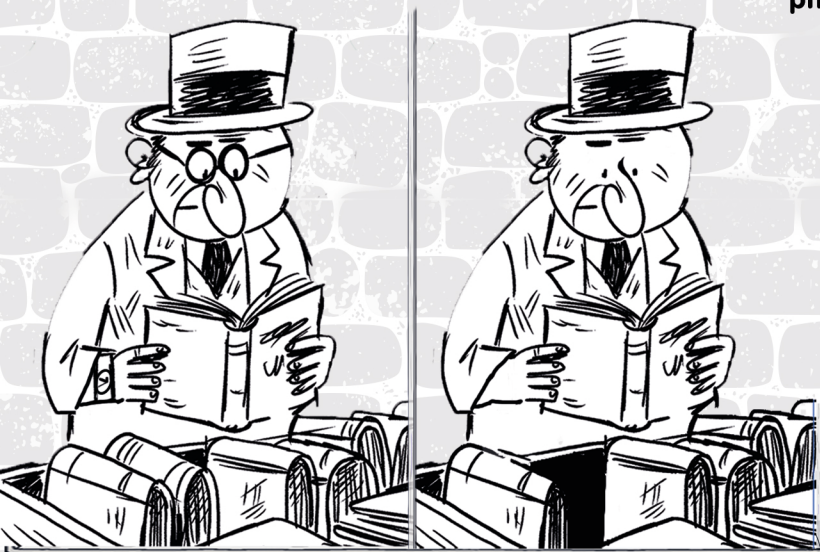

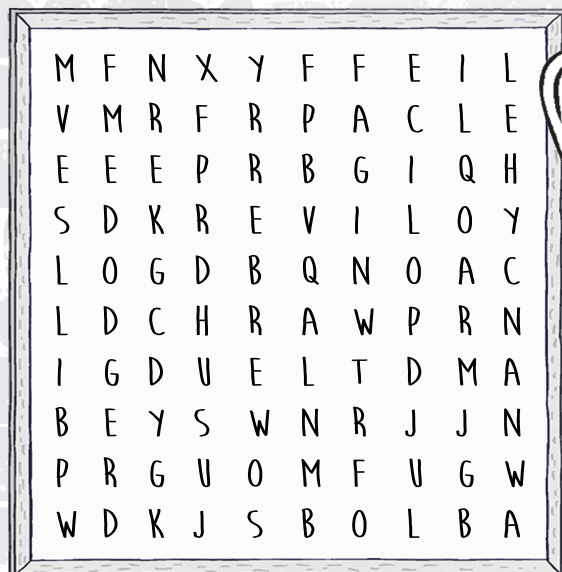
